# BARKATULLAH UNIVERSITY, BHOPAL Ordinance No. - 278 SCHEME OF EXAMINATION AND COURSE OF STUDY

For

Four Year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) B.Sc.B.Ed. (Secondary)/B.A.B.Ed.(Secondary)

The National Education Policy 2020 highlights. "Teacher education is vital in creating a pool of school teachers that will shape the next generation. Teacher preparation is an activity that requires multidisciplinary perspectives and knowledge, formation of dispositions and values, and development of practice under the best mentors. Teachers must be grounded in Indian values, languages, knowledge, ethos, and traditions including tribal traditions, while also being well-versed in the latest advances in education and pedagogy" [Para 15.1, NEP-2020].

Four-Year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP): "Recognizing that the teachers will require training in high quality content as well as pedagogy, teacher education will gradually be moved by 2030 into multidisciplinary colleges and universities" [Para 5.22, NEP-2020].

"The 4-year integrated B.Ed. offered by such multidisciplinary HEIs will by 2030, become the minimal degree qualification for school teachers. The 4-year integrated B.Ed. will be a dual major holistic bachelor's degree, in Education as well as a specialised subject such as a language, history, music. mathematics, computer science, chemistry, economics, art, physical education, etc. Beyond the teaching of cutting-edge pedagogy, the teacher will include grounding in sociology, history, science, psychology, early childhood care and education, foundational literacy and numeracy, knowledge of India and its values/ethos/art/traditions, and more: [Para 15.5, NEP-2020].

In order to translate the policy in to practice, National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE), the apex body of Teacher Education of the country formulated Curriculum Framework for ITEP.

The four year Integrated Teacher Education Programme in Science/Artsshall lead to the degree of B.Sc.B.Ed./B.A.B.Ed. The degree course shall consist of four academic years, distributed in eight semesters. There will be an examination at the end of each semester and after 8 semesters lead to the degree of Bachelor of Arts and Bachelor of Education. The Programme, however, may be completed within a maximum period of six years from the date of admission.

The ITEP is of four years duration across eight semesters of study. It is a dual-major bachelor's degree programme, with one major in Education and the other in disciplinary/interdisciplinary branch of knowledge. In addition, the programme seeks to develop among student-teachers an ethic of social engagement, and capacities such as problem solving, critical thinking, creative thinking, communication skills, ethical and moral reasoning, etc., that are necessary for

preparing competent teachers. The ITEP envisages multiple entry and exit points and re-entry options, with appropriate certifications.

#### 2. Eligibility/Entry Requirements

A candidate who after having passed:

- Senior/Higher Secondary school certificate examination of the board of secondary education any state/UT/ICSE/CBSE of India with at least 50% marks.
- (ii) Any other examination recognized as equivalent by the University/Central/State Government.
- (iii) Relaxation of 5% marks for SC, ST and PwD candidates.

Credit-hours for Courses of Study: Taught courses involving classroom teaching and structured interaction require a minimum of 15 hours of instructional/contact time per credit in a semester. Practicum requiring students to participate in an approved project or practical activity will require a minimum of 30 hours of student engagement per credit in a semester. This will be applicable to activities such as seminars, internships, lab-based activities, studio activity, workshop-based activity, field-based learning/project and practices, community engagement and service, etc.

Choice of Specialisation and Major Areas of Study: Student-teachers are expected to choose their major areas of study for the ITEP.

Multiple Entry and Exit, and Re-entry Options: The ITEP envisages multiple entry and exit points and re-entry options, with appropriate certifications. Student-teachers who wish to exit after completion of one year (two semesters) of study will be given a Certificate indicating the credits accrued for the courses pursued. Student-teachers who wish to exit after completion of two years (four semesters) will be given a Diploma indicating the credits accrued for the courses completed. Student-teachers who wish to exit after successful completion of three years (six semesters) will be awarded a Bachelor's Degree in the chosen Major area of study upon securing a minimum of 120 credits and satisfying the minimum of credit requirements of 64 credits for the Major. In addition, a minimum of 16 credits in disciplinary/interdisciplinary a Minor.

Student-teacher who successfully completes four years (eight semesters) of study will be awarded a dual-major bachelor's degree such as B.Sc.B.Ed./B.A.B.Ed. upon securing a minimum of 160 credits, including a minimum of 96 credits for the first major (i.e. education), and a minimum of 64 credits for the second major (i.e. in a disciplinary/interdisciplinary area relating to one of the curricular areas in school education). In addition, a minimum of 16 credits in disciplinary/interdisciplinary as Minor.

#### Promotion

Promotion from one semester to the next semester will be independent of pass or fail in examination provided the candidate has satisfied the course and attendance requirements and provided a candidate fails in not more than two subjects and clears all the remaining subjects, he/she will be 'Allowed To Keep the Term - ATKT' and will be automatically promoted to next semester but the course will have to be completed within six years.

- A candidate with four ATKT will be admitted but in any case he/she will not be allowed to have more than two ATKT in a semester.
- (ii) A candidate who fails in more than two subjects in any semester will not be eligible to get admission in next semester, till he/she clears it as an ex-student.
- (iii) No separate examination for ATKT candidates will be conducted. Odd semester ATKT examination will be held with odd semester and even semester ATKT examination will be held with even semester examination.
- (iv) A candidate who fails to clear ATKT in two chances will not be allowed admission to next semester and will appear the examination as an ex-student as per the point (ii).
- (v) There will be no provision of revaluation in theory/practical/internal/project work. However, candidates can apply for re-totalling of marks in one theory subject per semester.
- (vi) A candidate failing in theory subjects of a semester but securing minimum Pass marks in internal/project work/practical then the marks secured in practical/ internal will be carried forward in the next examination of the concerned subject.
- 3.(a) Every student of the teacher education institution seeking admission to examination shall have to submit an application on prescribed form together with necessary fees and the following certificates from the Principal, viz. certificate of-
  - Having attended at least 80% of lectures/seminars, practicum/practical laboratory work etc. in theory papers and 90% in internship.
  - (ii) Good conduct.
  - (b) If the Principal of the Institute is unable to grant, in respect of any student, any of the certificates referred to in sub-para (a) above he/she shall have to forward a statement of grounds of his/her inability to do so to the Registrar for consideration of the Vice-Chancellor who may after holding such further enquiry, if any, as he/she deems necessary order for allowing the candidate for appearing in the examination or otherwise, in accordance with the merit of the case.
  - (c) Deficiency in attendance, not exceeding fifteen percent may be, on the recommendation of the Principal of the Institute, condoned by the Vice-Chancellor in accordance with the provisions of para 5 of the Ordinance relating to examinat ion (General).
- Every candidate for each semester examination shall be examined in the subjects as given in structure of the course.
- 5. (a) The examination shall be conducted by means of written tests in theory papers and also in practical, in the case of such subject that has practical training prescribed by the Board of Studies.

- (b) The scheme of examinations for different parts shall be as shown in the Structure.
- (c) The scope of studies in different subjects for an examination shall be as prescribed by the Academic Council on the recommendation of the Board of Studies and the Faculty of Education from time to time.
- The written part of the Semester Examination shall be held in December/May, every year. The date of commencement of the examination will be notified by the Registrar, well-in-advance.
  - (ii) The practical part of examination in the subjects in which such practical are prescribed may be arranged either before or after the written examination in accordance with the convenience of the Institute. This will be notified well-in advance with prior approval of the Registrar.
  - (iii) The examination(s) for the back-log part(s) shall be held along with the concerned semester(s) examination for such candidates who are eligible for appearing in the examination. There shall be no supplementary or second examination, in this regard.
- 7. (a)In order to be successful at any of the examinations for the B.Sc.B.Ed./B.A.B.Ed.degree, an examinee must secure a minimum of 40% marks in each subject and 40% marks in aggregate of all subjects offered by him/her mentioned in Structure of the course.
  - (b) Subject in which both theory and practical examinations are prescribed, one has to obtain 40% marks in theory and 50% in practical examination, separately. Internal will be treated as equivalent to practical.
- (a) There shall be no division assigned to the successful candidates of Semester 1 to Semester V Examination. The division will be assigned to successful candidates after VI Semester and VIII Semester examination.
  - (b) Successful candidates of B.Sc.B.Ed./B.A.B.Ed. Semester VIII examination will be placed in a division in accordance with the following scale on the basis of aggregate marks obtained in all the semesters, taken together:

40% or above but less than 50%:

Third Division

50% or above but less than 60%

Second Division

60% or above

First Division

75% or above

Distinction

Division will be awarded on the basis of the marks secured in the Major subjects, i.e., in Education and Science (Physics/Chemistry/Mathematics/Botany/Zoology)/ Arts (English/Hindi/Gujarati/Marathi/Urdu/History/Political Science/Geography/Economics)

(c) Successful examinees at the B.Sc.B.Ed./B.A.B.Ed. Examination shall be placed in division, separately, for the part of B.Sc./B.A. and B.Ed. as follows, but according to the scheme mentioned.

- In the B.Sc./B.A., taking into account the total marks obtained in the subjects in semester I to VI, together.
- (ii) In theB.Ed. subjects taking into account the total marks obtained in semester I to VIII. together.
- One grace mark in each semester will be given either for clearing/pass or for improvement in division in the final semester.
- A candidate is to be declared successful at the examination of B.Sc.B.Ed./B.A.B.Ed.course, has to clear two components, namely, B.Sc./B.A. and B.Ed., separately.
- Candidates who have ATKT (back) in any subject(s) in any examinations(odd/even semesters
  will have to appear at the concerned subsequent examination of the (odd/even semesters).
- The Executive Council shall publish the results of the examination by notifying the Roll Nos. and names of successful candidates within 60 days from the date of last examination.
- 13. In the notification, declaring the results of the B.Sc.B.Ed./B.A.B.Ed. VIII semester examination names of first 10 successful examinees who have secured first division shall be arranged in order of merit, provided the examinee secures first division in both the parts, namely, B.Sc./B.A. and B.Ed.
- 14. A successful candidate shall be entitled only for combined degree B.Sc.B.Ed. (Secondary)/B.A.B.Ed.(Secondary) with Major in Physics/ Chemistry/ Mathematics/ Botany/ Zoology/ English/ Hindi/ Marathi/ Gujarati/ Urdu/ History/ Political Science/ Geography/Economics and Education under ITEP.
- 15. Instructions for each semester in the concerned course of study shall be provided as per norms laid down by the university. The academic calendar of each semester will be notified, well-inadvance.
- 16. Vertical Mobility Opportunities: A candidate who successfully completed the four year ITEP and wanted to pursue higher studies will be eligible to pursue master's degree programme in education as well as major discipline chosen for study during ITEP.
- The examination scheme will be prepared by the Board of Studies (Education) and can be modified time to time as per need.
- In case of any dispute/ambiguity, the ruling of the university and decision of Vice- Chancellor will be final.
