universities, including buildings of teaching department, Hostels, administrative block, Class rooms, laboratories, computer lab, water management system facility, electric facility, Road and gardening is done by the collaboration of University Engineering department, store and account section of the university. There is a separate engineering office govern by university engineers and officers. On the basis of funds allocation in particular head (UGC grant received by Development section under the head of Maintainance of physical, academic and supports facilities) , the work of engineering office is to look after the repair and maintainance of the university buildings. Repairing and maintainance of building as well as support facilities is done by coordination with the development, store and account section of the university. Store section keeps maintaining the record of academic facility like, Scientific or Non- scientific Instruments, Furniture, computers, laboratories minor instruments, chemicals etc. For procurement of major equipment for UTD is being done by e- tendering for repairing or purchasing above said requirements. All the laid down procedure governs by General Finance Rules from central / state purchase rules as per approval from finance officer of university. Most of the Computers and Instruments maintainance done through Annual Maintainance Contract (AMC) or similar other process. Customs duty exemption certificate is issued for any equipment imported by the university. Barkatullah University Bhopal is also known for its greenery. The green initiative of the university and Maintainance of garden, parks and lawns of the universities is also done by gardeners, caretakers to assist the head in the upkeep and Maintainance of the building infrastructure. The routine daily cleanness and securities of the central offices, departments, hostels and staff building is done through private agencies staff. Well stocked central library is the landmark place of Barkatullah university. There are 75000 books, almost 6000 references Books, 3000 research magazines, 3782 e books, 5703 thesis and 60 Sanskrit MSS. This central library is maintaining and governs by permanent university staff. Except the central library there are also separate library in most of the university teaching department. ICT infrastructure at the university is maintained and governed by its own university teaching department. There are one computer center having PG courses offered for the student of Computer science and Information technology. With the help of University Engineering department, development, store and account section of the university, maintaining the university sports facilities includes Gymnasium, and Game fields and also other types of facilities like well equipped one museum, Health Center Psychological CounselingCenter mechanical workshop Cultural Hall and an auditorium. 4 girls common rooms, Banking and Post Office facilities.

Curriculum Development	? Barkatullah University have Board of Study Committees in all the subjects for Curriculum design and development. In addition the Department of Higher Education also constituted Central Board of Study Committee for Curriculum development both for UG and PG courses. The regular meetings of both the Board of Studies conducted from time to time for Curriculum development and deployment. In June 2019, Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) was introduced for all PG level courses in University Teaching Department for which the scheme and the syllabus was framed by concerned Board of Study for the courses running in University Teaching Departments.
Teaching and Learning	? Regular teaching of all the courses are going on as per the Academic schedule of the university. The faculty covers the syllabus within the stipulated period but in case if the syllabus is not covered due to any undefined reason, the course is covered by engaging the remedial classes by the

	faculty. The teaching is done both by Black Board and Audio-Visual aid including Smart Classrooms. As far as learning is concerned the students have been given assignments and project work as a part of their curriculum and are exposed to various seminars, symposia, workshops, and training programme from time to time. Fieldwork is also conducted as a part of curriculum in some of the courses as requirement of the subject.
Examination and Evaluation	? The performance of the students are evaluated both by Internal and External examination, scheduled by Confidential Section of the University. The assignments given to students are evaluated by the internal faculty members besides the practical examination in science subjects. For external examination the answer sheets are given bar codes to maintain confidentiality of the students. All the answer books are evaluated both by Central Valuation and by sending the answer books to examiners with coding and decoding system. Attempts are made to maintain all possible level of confidentiality and to maintain the academic schedule of the university
Research and Development	<pre>? The students are admitted to Ph.D. programmes available in different subjects through online process, followed by written test on OMR sheet. The successful candidates given seat as per the concerned Ph.D. Ordinance of the university. A care has been taken while finalizing the Research Topic in RDC, that it should be of applied nature and have relevance for the development of the society. To encourage the research in the subject, the IQAC of Barkatullah University has organized a Research Seminar exclusively for the Research Scholars of the University Teaching Departments during this academic year. ? In order to encourage the research and development, the Barkatullah University provides funding to the projects submitted by faculty members in different subjects. ? In addition the students are also given the scholarship for their research work by the university.</pre>
Library, ICT and Physical Infrastructure / Instrumentation	? Beside the Central facility of library, every department in the

	University has its departmental library. The Central Library is well equipped with WiFi facility and furnished reading rooms for the students. The Central Library consist of about 89866 books with about 1500 titles. During this academic year books worth of Rs. 5 lac have been ordered in different subjects. ? In Science, Life Science, Technology and Engineering Faculty, every department is equipped with the instruments useful for classroom teaching/practical and research purposes. In addition the University has its own central instrumentation facility known as USIC.
Human Resource Management	? The field of specialization of the faculty members have been used as Human Resources of the University. Faculty members provides consultancy and give popular lectures on different themes of science and society development programme. The Yoga Department of the University running the yoga classes for the citizens of Bhopal on regular basis.
Industry Interaction / Collaboration	? Many Departments of Barkatullah University have linkages with many industries particularly in the field of Science, Life science, Technology, Social sciences, Commerce and Law etc. The students of these departments used to visit industries for academic purposes and underwent training with the expertise available with them. During 2018 - 2019, the Barkatullah University has signed collaborative MOUs with AMPRI, CEDMAP, and IISS institute of National interest.
Admission of Students	? In Barkatullah University, the admission of students are made through advertisement in news papers and on website of the university. The Applications are invited through online process in regular University Teaching Departments whereas for professional courses like Pharmacy, Engineering and Management the admission of students are made through counselling carried out by Department of Technical Education (DTE). The admissions are made on the basis of merit and if the seats are available the admission is made through CLC. The Barkatullah University attracts the attention of students not only from Madhya Pradesh but throughout the country and abroad.

For Ph.D. programmes the admission of students are made through online process followed by written test and the seats are allocated to the students on the basis of merit in different subjects.

#### 7.3 – Institutional Distinctiveness

7.3.1 – Provide the details of the performance of the institution in one area distinctive to its vision, priority and thrust in not more than 500 words

Spread in 380 acres of land of BU is committed to achieve greenery across the entire campus. More than 100 verities of rare plants having aesthetic and medicinal properties can be seen in the lush green campus of BU. To sustain and maintain the green cover Plantation drive is carried out at periodic intervals. The University is making all attempt to make the campus plastic free. Furthermore, There are 15 earthen ponds in the campus for retaining rain water for about three to nine months. In the same continuation a model of roof top harvesting system has been installed in the department of Zoology and Applied Aquaculture. Conservation of engendered flora and fauna like Flucortiaindica and Gmlinaarborea is attempted by the university. For reducing water footprints attempt is made to print the documents on both side of the paper. All the important circulars and information are made available on e mail to reduce paper wastage. Recently, on the initiative of Alumni of Microbiology department at a pilot scale a vernicomposting unit of two tons capacity has been stated. Biodegradable waste is collected from the household and disposed here for vermicomposting.

Extend the University's commitment to excellence in teaching and its focus on creativity, entrepreneurship, environmental planning, ethics and value systems, and commitment to social equity and justice along with empowerment to its various departments, affiliated colleges and institutions. ? Ensure improvement of classroom conditions and enable better infrastructure facilities for laboratories, multiple-use areas, faculty offices, research support and aesthetic user areas for support staff, such as attendants and office assistants. ? Provide policy innovations and intervene through proactive facilitation to allow the University, its affiliated colleges and institutions, to continue to attract and retain faculty who combine the finest scholarship in spite of a demanding teaching schedule because of a sincere concern for their students. The Campus Plan The Campus Plan revolves around different Initiatives. There is a need to recognize and consider a holistic plan within the campus to provide financial commitment to departmental requirements for enhancements for classrooms, laboratories and faculty and student utilities or recreational space. The Future Plan document proposes to establish new, better, larger, aesthetic yet ecofriendly standards for buildings that would be proposed within the Campus. The Initiatives for the Campus are: 1. Establish a futuristic, 100 computer-enabled,

student-friendly facilitation centerto ensure automation and immediate response to requests for statutory processes, such as admissions and examinations, easy-touse library and ID cards. 2. Ensure conservation of the historical water management principles and facilities existing within the Campus. Support local water drainage, seepage and underground storage of water by undertaking massive plantation of evergreen trees through an Environment policy. 3. Through an Energy Audit, ensure energy conservation, and generation of at least 40 of outdoor campus electricity from alternative sources. Include the development of large parking areas near the exit doors from the Campus to the City, and thereafter, in a phased manner, prevent polluting vehicles from entering the Campus. 4. On the theme of Smart Campus facilities will be generated with internal road systems, eco-friendly internal transport systems, internet cafes, subject-specific libraries and e-libraries, recreational facilities. 5. Construct additional facilities for boys' hostels, and ensure open integration with the rest of the Campus. In addition, provide for and develop multi-location cafeteria. 6. Expand and enhance the Library facility, by creation of new reading halls, exclusive multi-use internet-enabled computer-supported cubicles within existing reading halls for students and faculty. Plan, create and establish a holistic Sports complex, around the current sports grounds by constructing athletic and other games. The Academic Plan The goals of the University under Academic Plan define the broad areas within which this Vision document develops specific strategies and initiatives. By including an initiative related to ongoing efforts, this plan affirms the importance of such activities and proposed to focus more energy on that area and push it higher on the university's agenda. The Initiatives are: 1. Recruit faculty in different departments immediately. Most of the departments are functioning with subcritical human resources for the past five to ten years and have pointed out urgent need for filling up these posts. 2. Effect academic, administrative and financial autonomy to ensure that decisions are taken immediately. The Heads of Departments in consultation with the Departmental Committee must be empowered to take appropriate decisions (within the rules and regulations) by delegating authority to them. 3. Ensure academic, administrative and financial autonomy to allow Departments to initiate self-financing programmes, with delegated powers of administration and finance management to the Heads of Department. 4. Provide special status and privileges to those teachers who publish in peer review Journals with high Impact Factor. Similarly, encourage the development of department-specific journals and research monographs, to establish a leadership role for the University through high-visibility publications along with strengthening of the University Press. 5. Enhance interdisciplinary teaching programme by institutionalising the credit and semester system. 6. Introduce teacher assessment by students and develop a feedback system for ensuring quality of teaching programs. 7. Establish Scholarships and or Fee waivers by designing a transparent, socially sensitivemerit-driven system with a variable approach comprising 8. Review and amalgamate if necessary the current academic departments, disciplines and programs to remove any duplication and encourage at least 25 of credit transfers from other disciplines. 9. Establish Centreof Excellence (COE) in different Departments under World Bank Project. Permit Departments desirous of running advanced academic programme leading to Master's degree in a major and a minor discipline as well as in Interdisciplinary subjects. 10. Develop an academic and research network with other Universities/Institutions in the Region, to encourage collaboration, common teaching and research programs. 11. Attract students from other States and other nations and to make the student population more diverse. Create appropriate secure and aesthetic facilities for students from other regions, including specific international student's facilities. 12. Involve industry and voluntary organizations in curricula design, teaching and research through the strengthening of the Science and Technology Park and establishment of internships for students in local industry, developing entrepreneurial incubator facilities, electronic networking server farms to provide external studentships,

industrial campus classrooms, net based studentships and evening and night schools. We are confident that Barkatullah University will become a more vibrant centre of excellence to address all challenges. It will show path for prosperity, cohesion, development and brotherhood at different levels.
