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INVITATION AND CALL FOR PAPERS

CONTEXT AND RATIONALE

With the objective of finding Indian solutions to Indian problems, Barkatullah University is set to organize a two-day workshop on "Indian Knowledge System and Research" on 25th and 26th July 2024. The workshop primarily seeks to preserve and promote research on/ with Indian Knowledge Systems (IKS) in different subject areas to promote and foster innovation, and cultivate a deep understanding of Traditional Indian Knowledge Systems, and to find solutions to present-day problems with the application of IKS for the betterment of society. We are all aware of the parexcellence architectural marvels that we see strewn across the length and breadth of India! The fineness of sculptural remains in Ajanta Elora are unparalleled in the world, not only in terms of aesthetics but also technology. There is a lesser appreciation of mundane things like the products of the potter or the broomsticks, textiles, etc., we continue to use every day. What is the methodology of Indian Knowledge System that made all this possible? How were the knowledge fields systematization as knowledge fields or Sastra? It is well known that each Sastra has a clearly defined purpose in *Vyavahara* and many examples of the continuity of these knowledge areas may be seen in the traditional practices of our vivid artisans and craftsmen, whose work continues to be based on the ancient knowledge system and its practice. When we look at the problems created by modern technology, one wonders where it will end. Look at the dooming environmental crises the world may be annihilated by this alone, what of other things! Yet in IKS the means of valid knowledge through Pramanas, Perception (Pratyaksha), Inference (Anumana) and Textual Tradition (Agama), as discussed in the canonical texts of all the

disciplines point towards a methodological premise that ultimately upholds the well-being of not only human society but the entire cosmos. Understanding IKS and working with it may help in building a better world for one and all. Thus, the need to better understand its premises, methods, and practices.

Authors are requested to give final shape to their papers latest by 4th August and follow the required format as given by Higher Education. The decision of the screening Committee will be final and binding. The book will be published by Hindi Granth Academy, Madhya Pradesh.

- To develop mechanisms to familiarise students with a basic understanding of IKS (concepts and theoretical formulations) at the UG, PG as well as Ph.D. levels;
- 2. To develop mechanisms for incorporating IKS in academics;

- 4. To identify ways by which the outputs of research be made relevant to Indian society by situating it in IKS;
- 5. Identify areas of research in IKS to deepen its understanding in academics;
- 6. Book on "Indian Research Traditions: Approach and Methodology".
