6. The candidates awaiting their results of qualifying examination can also apply for the admission in courses, but their final admission to the course shall be required passed in qualifying examination as per eligibility criteria.

8. After Submission of Application form, Candidates are required to send Print Out of Application along with mark sheets, Certificates etc. by post to Head of Concerned Teaching Department.
